Memorandum of Agreement- Extension-Effective July 1, 2021 and Expiring June 30, 2022.


This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is entered into by and between The Office of the Governor of Maryland, the Maryland State Department of Education (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "State") and Service Employees International Union, Local 500, CtW (hereinafter referred to as the "Union").

In accordance with § 5-595.3 of the Family Law Article, the State and the Union have met and negotiated on matters of concern to the parties pertaining to family child care providers covered by the above referenced law.


The State and the Union agree to the current terms of the Memorandum of Agreement dated July 1, 2018-June 30, 2021 and further extend this Memorandum of Agreement for one year covering the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

In as much as the parties are negotiating in good faith to complete and sign a Memorandum of Agreement as soon as possible, this extension is for the sole purpose of accomplishing that goal. All terms, conditions, and obligations of both parties shall remain in full force and effect until a new Memorandum of Agreement has been signed. This extension of the Memorandum of Agreement shall remain in force through June 30, 2022, or until such time that a new Memorandum of Agreement has been signed, whichever comes first.


